

HIPÓDROMO DE LA ZARZUELA S.A., S.M.E., PAYMENT AND COLLECTION PROCEDURE
FOR NON-RESIDENTS IN SPAIN

1. The owner must have an internal management account set up with the data requested on this form in order to enter a horse in any of the races organised by HIPÓDROMO DE LA ZARZUELA, S.A., S.M.E.
2. The owner must have sufficient funds in their internal management account to cover the all-in expenses, additional entries, non-runner or runner in the race in which they wish to enter. The prices of each of these concepts are available in the General Terms and Conditions of the Racing Programme of each season, duly approved by the JOCKEY CLUB ESPAÑOL DE LAS CARRERAS DE CABALLOS (JCE – SPANISH JOCKEY CLUB).
3. Should there not be sufficient funds in the internal management account of the owner, HIPÓDROMO DE LA ZARZUELA hereby reserves the right to accept a provisional entry, which will be cancelled if the required amount is not deposited in the internal management account in the three days following the entry date.

5. The amount of the prizes won by the owners (80% of the amount announced in the Programme), along with the percentages for the trainers (10%) and jockeys (10%) will be credited in the relevant internal management account of each of them.
6. In order to collect those amounts, the holders of the internal management accounts (owners, trainers and jockeys) will always be required to submit the relevant invoice for each prize in question, with all the necessary information, plus VAT, which shall be 0% when the invoice is issued by companies that are EU intracommunity operators, and 21% otherwise.
7. HIPÓDROMO DE LA ZARZUELA pays the invoiced amounts on the 15th of each month.

8. The holder of the internal management account (owner, trainer or jockey, whether a private individual or company, intracommunity operator or not) will likewise be required to produce a certificate of their tax residence, valid for one year, in order to be able to collect 100% of the amount invoiced, pursuant to the double taxation treaties in place between Spain and their country of residence for tax purposes.
9. Should the winner of a prize (owner, owner, trainer or jockey, whether a private individual or company, intracommunity operator or not) resident for tax purposes outside Spanish territory does not produce such a certificate, HIPÓDROMO DE LA ZARZUELA shall have to apply the appropriate withholding rate pursuant to Spanish legislation, and which shall be 24% of the invoiced amount in 2018.
10. Processing of personal data: You as the Professional or Owner are hereby informed and expressly agree to your data being incorporated in the future and existing HZ automated files.
